

## Manual DBIR Invalid entries report per surgeon

### General

The *invalid entries report per surgeon* shows the errors and warnings per patient within the registration. The biggest difference with the regular **invalid entries report** is that this list also shows the treating surgeon. This list is therefore (mainly) intended for the individual surgeon.

By clicking on a row in the report, you will be redirected to the relevant dataset in Survey. In this way, the changes can be made immediately. After that the report must be **refreshed**. To do so reload the browser page by clicking the refresh button or by pressing F5 on the keyboard.

*Please note: it can take up to 10 seconds for the changes to take effect. Do not refresh the page too quickly.*

### Headers of the report

Surgeon	UPN	Name	Date of birth	Dataset	Reference	Variable		Issue
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<b>Surgeon</b>	The name of this surgeon
<b>UPN</b>	UPN = Unique Patient Number of each patient
<b>Name</b>	The name of the patient
<b>Date of birth</b>	Date of birth of the patient
<b>Dataset</b>	The dataset of the error / warning: 1. Patient / 2. Surgery / 3. Side / 4. Device
<b>Reference</b>	Reference of the dataset as shown in Survey For 'Patient' the BSN is replaced by UPN
<b>Variable</b>	The variable within the registration with the error or warning
<b>Color sign</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Warning:</b> unlikely value has been entered</li> <li>● <b>Error:</b> the value is not entered or entered incorrectly</li> </ul>
<b>Issue</b>	The warning / error message

### Sorting

The invalid entries report per surgeon can be sorted on one column by using the sort (arrow) keys behind the column header name. One click is ascending, second click is descending and after that the sorting is deleted.

Default sorting is on Surgeon, UPN, Name, Date of birth, Dataset, Variable.
